HAMAARI SADA TRUST

Hamaari Sada Trust' was founded by Mohd. Irshad Alam on 17th June 2016 exempted under sections 11 to 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961. The Trust was founded to bring changes in the lives of vulnerable masses. Initially, Trust aimed to work with those school dropouts who were unable to continue their education due to financial problems in the family.

Since beginning, Hamaari Sada Trust (HST) aimed to start an educational & awareness program for children and society. So HST initiated two projects of its own with the help of few friends from media and some volunteers. We began with Project 'Shiksha' and 'Fit' in Madanpur Khadar, New Delhi and slowly extended the reach to few more villages in Uttar Pradesh.

OUR VISION

Vision of the Trust is to restore the lives of children, women and other vulnerable sections through necessary interventions. Trust visualizes a society in which Education and Health facilities are accessible to every individual.

MISSION

Establish, maintain and carry out humanitarian activities to improve the quality of life of the neglected people.

The focus areas of the work being done at Hamaari Sada Trust are very clear. HST is an endeavour:

- to create self-sustaining employment opportunities for the women and youth
- to promote and encourage the education, welfare, empowerment and the uplift of women and children

- to undertake the research and analysis project related to women and youth issues
- to work in the field of mediamaking films, documentaries, programmes, etc
- to promote the various causes which HST and other organisations are working for

PROJECTS

I-AUJ-E-FALAK SHIKSHA CENTRE

Hamaari Sada Trust has been running a Shiksha center by the name of 'Auj-e-Falak Shiksha Centre' since 1st October 2022. This education center is located in Madanpur Khadar JJ Colony of Delhi.

The purpose of an education center for remedial classes is to provide additional support and resources to students who are struggling academically in specific subjects or areas.

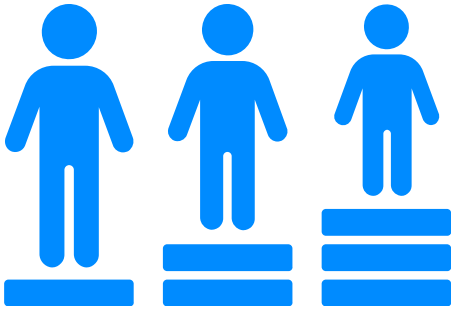

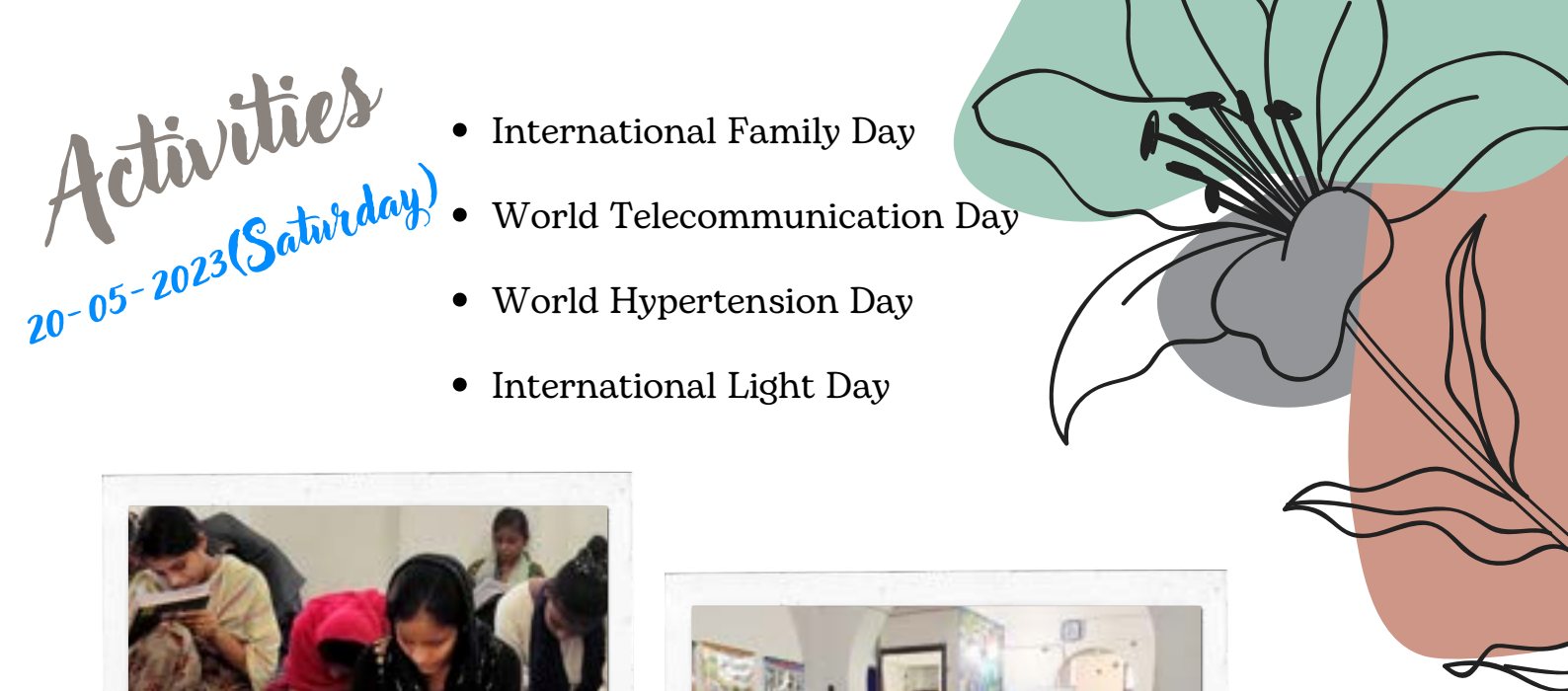

In addition, the centre requested parents to:

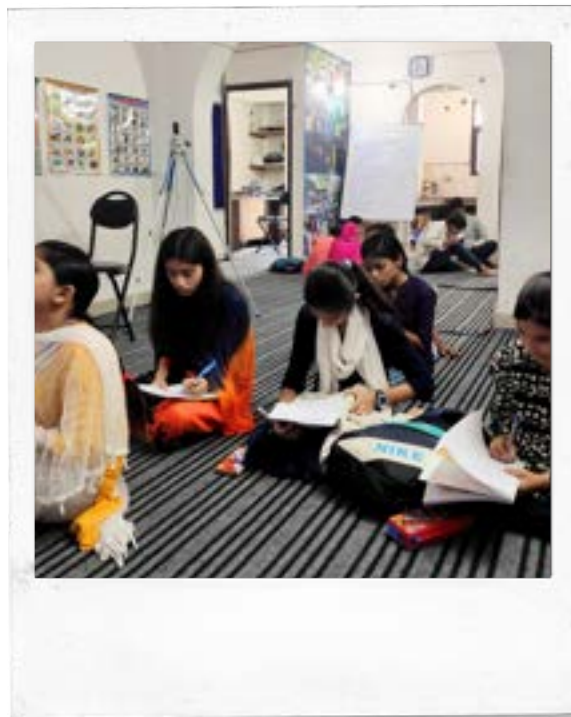
- Communicate with the teachers if they have any questions or concerns.

“Dowries are customary in our community. When a person get married, that person should made it as practice to never accept dowry, or he should make sure that he would never accept dowry if his child was a boy,” she emphasized .

All of the participant's questions were addressed, and the answers were satisfactory. The gathering, which took place at Auj-e-Falak Shiksha Centre, attracted about 125 community women and female students.

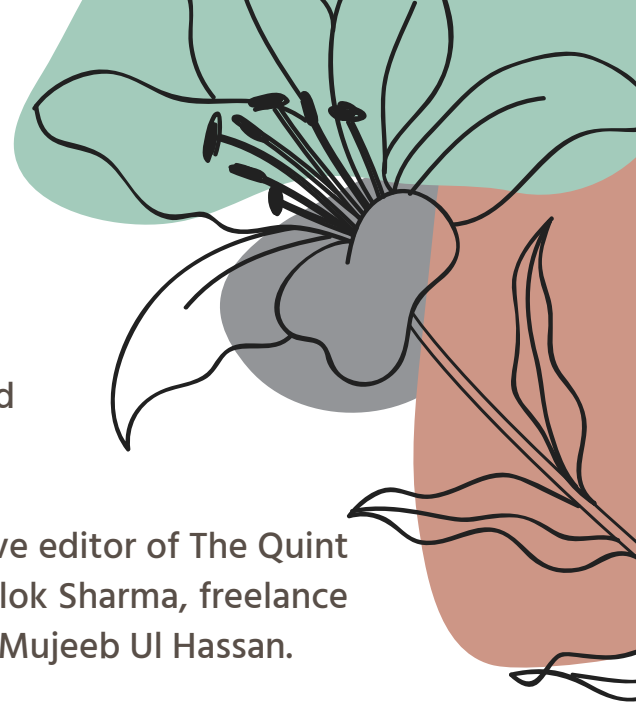


Engineer Ayesha Ayubi stated, "Education is the only path to achieving your dream; consistency will ease this path; do not lose hope, keep studying, do not distract."

II-PROJECT 'SHIKSHA'

"Shiksha" is the Trust's inaugural project which aims to provide education to school dropouts and children belonging to low socio-economic backgrounds through remedial education. Trust also efforts to enroll neglected children in school and try to provide required assistance to save their childhood. Trust follows the holistic approach to educating children which includes awareness, counseling, and providing necessary items like stationary and financial support to those who cannot afford school expenses. the project was expanded to the rural area of Varanasi, Village Kathiraon, Post Office Kathiraon, Uttar Pradesh.

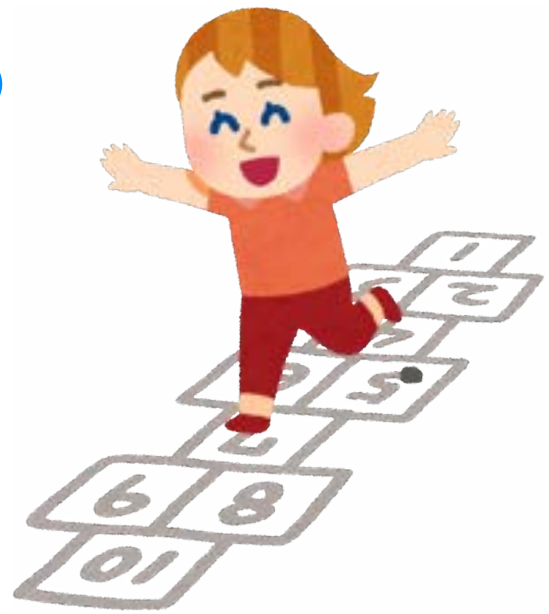

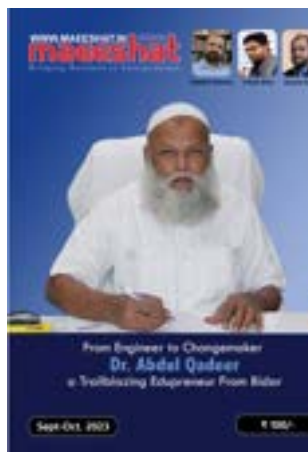
PROJECT 'RELIEF'
