Education & Skill Development

Hamaari Sada Trust organised multiple educational and skill development initiatives including tuition support, PTM sessions, multimedia summer camps, spoken English activities, communication workshops, and creative learning programs for students from Class 1 to graduation level.



Media Orientation and Advocacy

The Trust conducted hands-on sessions on photography, videography, video editing, anchoring, script writing, voice-over, and social media awareness with the support of media professionals and journalists. Students also participated in real-life documentation and storytelling projects during community welfare programs.



6-Day Multimedia Summer Camp at Rising Skill Development Centre (RSDC) By Hamaari Sada Trust

The camp hosted two separate programs:

“Creative Fun” Activities” – for 1st to 9th class students, including engaging sessions in art & craft, poetry, storytelling, educational games, and team activities to boost imagination and collaborative learning.

“Multimedia: Lights, Camera, Learn” – for students from class 10 to graduation, aged 15 to 25 years. This module will introduce participants to the world of multimedia, including lighting, camera operation, and the basics of content creation.

Freelance Journalist / Documentary Filmmaker, Asmita Nandy (awarded the Ramnath Goenka Award spoke on **“The Art of Reporting: Ground, Crime, Studio & More”** and shared his experience with students.



Multimedia journalist Azhar Ansar from newschecker.in engaged with the students on **“scriptwriting”** and shared valuable insights on script writing.

Students gained practical knowledge of photography and videography. Guest speaker AK Ranjit (Director, Media Lab and Instructor in Photography, Documentary and Broadcast Production at Ashoka University) Spoken on **Photography & Cinematography and explained key concepts, ranging from shutter speed to camera angles.**



Famous voice-over artist and journalist Hemant Saini spoke on **“Communication Skills and Voice Over”** in detail.

News18’s Senior journalist, senior video editor Parwez Shahin spoke on **“Video Editing and Graphics”** and explained the entire process of video editing through practical medium.



Aaj Tak journalist Sakib Mazeed spoke on **“Social Media Management”**. During this, he told the students about the advantages and disadvantages of social media. He also talked about its better use and precautions.

Students from Class 1 to 9 participated enthusiastically in a variety of engaging activities designed to spark imagination and creativity.



From fun-filled ice-breaking sessions to hands-on art, craft, and storytelling activities, the **day one** was filled with laughter, learning, and lively energy.

On the **second day**, students actively participated in the sessions and thoroughly enjoyed the experience. The atmosphere was filled with excitement, learning, and joyful energy, leaving the children inspired and happy.



On the **third day**, students explored important topics such as pollution and communication, gaining a deeper understanding through discussions and creative expression by Sana Fatima, a student of Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi.

On the **fourth day**, students delved into the fascinating world of child psychology through an engaging session conducted by Mohammad Saad, a student of Jamia Millia Islamia. Adding to the day's excitement, the thought-provoking film "Zootopia" was screened for the children, sparking meaningful conversations and reflections among the young minds. A perfect blend of learning and entertainment.



On the **fifth day** led by Saad Inam and Md. Alfaz Khan. The sessions covered important themes such as "Our Earth", "Who is a Good Person?", and "Misuse of Phones", encouraging students to think critically and express themselves. Following the discussions, students enthusiastically wrote essays and created imaginative drawings inspired by the topics.



On the **six day**, the young participants engaged in thought-provoking and creative sessions led by Saad Inam and Md. Alfaz Khan.

The final day began with a vibrant prize distribution ceremony, where winners from all six creative categories were honoured with 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes. A total of 71 students had participated in the camp, and several were also recognized with special awards for outstanding performance. The camp was held in collaboration with **Shaheen Group of Institutions, The Himalaya Drug Company, SIO Delhi, and Media Cares Foundation, with Sadaa Times as the official media partner.**

Health & Community Welfare

Hamaari Sada Trust, in collaboration with Dr. Shroff's Charity Eye Hospital, organised an Eye Camp at its Rising Skill Development Centre, Madanpur Khadar Extension, New Delhi, on Sunday, 31st August 2025. Nearly 80 children and parents underwent eye check-ups. 17 students were identified for spectacles, which will be provided free of cost. Some special children were also called to the hospital for further examination and treatment. Parents and elderly participants were screened for cataracts, glaucoma, and diabetic eye conditions. Patients requiring further treatment will receive it free of cost at Dr. Shroff's Charity Eye Hospital.



Cultural & Community Engagement

Hamaari Sada Trust organised Independence Day, Republic Day, Mushaira programs, community Iftar gatherings, and educational cultural events to strengthen unity, confidence, creativity, and community participation.

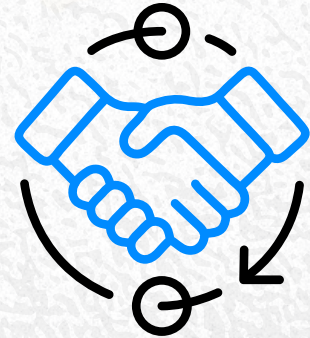

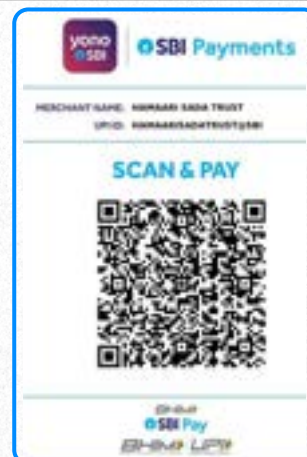
